Permits are required for any alteration to previously approved structure(s) or system(s) contained in your home; this includes finishing a basement, additions or changes to an electrical system, and even simply having your water heater replaced. As you might be aware, on April 21, 2010 the Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance 2010-3 amending Chapter 15 – Motor Vehicle and Traffic, with numerous revisions and additions to the regulation of streets and motor vehicles. We have been actively enforcing these regulations throughout the township and would like to bring to your attention some of the violations written.
